CHANGING THE WAY AMERICA THINKS

I'm sure that, along with me, you have noticed that our American society is becoming increasingly volatile, unstable, changeable, dangerous. We have ever-increasing demonstrations, picketing, frivolous lawsuits, personal and corporate bankruptcies, alcoholism, drug addiction, suicides in ever-growing numbers. What does this mean? It means that the great heart of our American society is beginning to fibrillate, to beat maniacally, to become uneven and unreliable. In human beings, this is a sign of great danger! In society, it is the same—it can be the prelude to the collapse and the death of a formerly viable culture which has lost direction, motivation, and a reason for living.

Let us make no mistake about it--cultures, like people, can die. Before they do, they give early warning signs, such as lack of confidence in government, the erosion of the prestige of religious leaders, demonstrations in society against their political officials, the rise of taxation to a confiscatory level and widespread moral irresponsibility on the part of the people. Is this happening today? How else can we explain the daily death toll of 4,000 abortions, the conferring on sodomites of "special" rights, the colossal rise in the national debt, the unspeakable foolishness of denominational leaders—a hundred evidences could be added to this.

We know, of course, that many Americans, many Christians, are dimly aware of the progressive ruin which is coming upon us in our American society. However, the problem seems to be so great and the enemy so well entrenched that many say, "There is nothing that I can do so I will hide my head in the sand. Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die." Seriously, there are multitudes of people who are checking out of any personal involvement in our modern, decadent culture. They anesthetize themselves with amusement, alcohol, sexual dissipation, or even involvement in some foggy little cultic religion. Such withdrawal from responsibility and great opportunity is a great mistake. Such people will miss the adventure of living today and will deprive society of the great things that, under God, they might otherwise do.

If not withdrawal, then what? Well, there are a hundred things that can be done by people and institutions in terms of their opportunity, ability, resources, and the like. We could suggest a score of activities that could yet produce a saving effect upon a deteriorating culture. Most of the alive, awake Christians of our time are at least doing something.

But at the bottom of it all, there is little hope unless we can do a very special thing—

we must change the way America thinks. We must produce a change of mind in the lives of thousands, millions of people if we are to alter the crash-dead-ahead direction of our society. There is no permanent change that can come in the world apart from getting sufficient numbers of people to think differently from the way they now think. In fact, the concerns of our society can easily be explained by noting the fact that most people simply believe the wrong things about God, about themselves, about the purpose of life.

About God, most people think that He either does not exist or is totally irrelevant to life. Consequently, it has been years since most people asked the question, “Who is God and what does He intend for me to do?” For want of proper attention to the question, they live like animals, motivated merely by pleasure or pain, rather than any sense of divine purpose.

The thinking Christian makes no such mistake. He knows that God is that holy and infinite Being who operates the universe with perfect attention and before whom some day we shall stand. To keep this truth in mind produces a profound effect upon the way we live.

Concerning man, the world believes that we are merely a result of an evolutionary process. Each individual is what he is because of accidental chemistry, mere chance, uncontrolled biological history. Every child, every young person who attends the public schools of America is taught that man is an animal. When a boy or girl believes such idiocy, how can we be surprised when they begin to live like animals when they arrive at their teenage years. Modern secular education guarantees future disaster by what is contained and what is omitted from the curriculum today.

The thinking Christian makes no such mistake. He knows that man is not an animal! Rather, man is an eternal being made in the image of God. He, therefore, is endowed with moral agency, responsibility, and divine destiny. The Christian mind is profoundly different from anything the world has to offer.

Concerning the purpose of life, the world has no answer. The world is secular, hedonistic, without a guiding star. With the help of John Dewey, the humanist father of modern education, the thinking of the world starts with man and ends with man. How incredibly depressing is the idea that life has no purpose beyond itself. “When you’re dead, you’re dead” is the ghastly best that the world can say when it faces the results of its own philosophy. People sicken and die from lack of purpose. How sad to face the darkness of a non-tomorrow without Christ.

The thinking Christian knows better. He knows that the purpose of life is not simply to exist, to be amused and intoxicated, to eat and indulge oneself and then die. He knows that “the Kingdom of God is not food and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit”(Rom. 14:17). He knows that the purpose of God reaches out into eternity, motivating him to live a thoughtful and godly life.

Why is it so impossible for groups of people to come to any agreement about what should be done concerning the critical issues of our time? The answer is that our society has lost any sense of a final standard by which things can be measured. In absence of this final standard, pompous people attempt to buttress their argument by saying, "Studies show . . .," "The experts say . . .," "The polls indicate . . .," "Our people want . . .," "The public has the right to know . . .," "My mother used to say . . .," and expressions along this line. Such "resources" should not be used as justification for anything!

These discussions become especially absurd when the subject is "morality." It is often heard that "You should not press 'your moral values' upon others." There is, of course, no such thing as "your" or "my" moral values. There is but one final authority. That is the Bible! Until the thought-leaders of our culture are willing to present the Bible as final authority in these matters, the senseless discussions will go on and on. All other implications of a given subject are pointless unless they are judged against a final authority.

Even as we speak, we sense that more and more atrocious people and ideas will move into positions of influence where they can control the lives of others. The Scripture says, "*He that rules over men must be just, ruling in the fear of God*" (II Sam. 23:3). That principle, if ignored, will produce the death of a nation.

How shall we then live in a world like this? Francis Schaeffer asked that question as the title of one of his books. Many years have passed since that book and the answer to the question is more complicated than ever. Nevertheless, there are several points that must be included in that answer:

(1) We shall live by faith in our unchanging God. The Scripture says five separate times-- "*the just shall live by faith*" (Rom. 1:17). Our confidence in the presiding power of God is unshakeable, whatever may be the vicissitudes of time. The whole point of Christianity is that the anchors of our hope are not placed in the shifting sands of these times. Rather, they rest upon the solid rock of divine truth.


(2) We shall live with eternity's values in view. The Scripture very clearly says -- how applicable it is to these times! -- "*If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable*" (I Cor. 15:19). We Christians have the bright hope of eternity before us. By comparison to that hope, nothing in this world should produce even an instant of anxiety. When we have eternity in mind, then we know the meaning of the statement of Scripture that says, "*For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, works for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory*" (II Cor. 4:17). One of these days we shall be carried up and out of this depraved culture to a land where there are no federal, state, or local taxes. The Bible calls heaven "the joy that is set before us" and that keeps us going with constancy.

(3) We shall live here the great adventure of life. Adventure means that we conduct our lives in the presence of opportunity, danger, challenge. We know that the wicked of our time will be turned into hell. We are given the challenging mission of winning as many of them to Christ as possible. We hope to do this before they drop into reprobation.

(4) **We shall tell this lost world anew that Jesus Christ is ready to save to the uttermost those that come unto God by Him.** One of the great statements of our mission in the world was presented by the Apostle Paul when he said, *"That you may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom you shine as lights in the world; Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither labored in vain"* (Phil. 2:15,16). This is the kind of ministry that we must conduct together as we labor for the Lord in these quickly passing days before the dawn of eternity.
