"THE PREFERRED EARTHQUAKE"

May 2005

A SPECTACULAR EVENT COMING!

An earthquake is a fantastic and, many times, terrible event. In our time, we have been hearing about earthquakes altering the landscape in many nations of the world. The record shows that earthquakes are happening with greater frequency and more severe impact than in any similar period of time in history. Nothing we have seen up until this time, however, compares with a devastatingly great earthquake which is still to come.

Describing this, the Apostle John says, "And I beheld when He had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood; And the stars of heaven fell to the earth, even as a fig tree casts her untimely figs,

"...and every mountain and island were moved out of their places." when she is shaken of a mighty wind. And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places" (Rev. 6:12-14).

Here we have a description of an absolutely awesome event. From this brief account in the Prophetic Word, some observations need to be made. This because, even reading these pages now, may well be persons who will be impacted by that incredible disturbance.

The first observation which is apparent is the fact that this earthquake will be a very smashing event. The light disappears when the sun becomes black as sackcloth of hair. The moon assumes a frightening appearance as it becomes like blood.

Accompanying this earthquake are a series of cosmic events as the stars of heaven fall to earth. Here we have not simply a meteor or two, but stars in such numbers so that this phenomenon is like a fig tree casting untimely figs when shaken by a mighty wind.

As if this were not enough, the heavens depart as a scroll and the mountains and the islands are moved out of their places. Obviously, nothing in all the earth will remain unshaken at the advent of this overwhelming quake.

As we read this frightening description, we remember that again and again earthquakes are described in the Bible as signs of divine judgment. Yes, it is apparent that the wickedness of men can even cause the earth to tremble. A little imagination invested in these words can cause in each of us almost a feeling of participation in this great form of the Judgment of Almighty God. We must learn and never forget that the universe. including this entire earth, is a fragile, destructible thing. What seems so solid can be blown away into dust by one puff of the breath of the eternal God. Millions have died earthquakes far more gentle than this one. An earthquake means the loss of everything and must certainly be called a frightening experience indeed.

We can make a second observation from this account in the Word of God. That is that there is coming an experience more frightening to natural men

than even this devastating earthquake. What is that experience? It is that inevitable event when sinful men will stand unprotected before the naked judgment of God. This awful earthquake is described as to its effect upon the men of earth: "And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every slave, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains" (Rev. 6:15). Cowering in the crevices the rulers of earth extended a great cry, they "said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of Him that sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb" (Rev. 6:16). So it will be that the tardy discernment of the brave and the beautiful of earth will esteem the wrath of God as a more devastating experience even than a mighty earthquake. Better to be crushed by a falling mountain than to stand undefended before the Judgment of the Eternal God. These rulers of earth suddenly developed a proper view of things, but alas, by that time it was too late.

Is there not a lesson here for all of mankind? The people of earth, living a tranquil life and presuming that tranquility will continue, give not a thought about the end of earth and the first day of eternity. Preoccupied with the fading things of time, they think not at all about the reality of eternity that is soon to break upon them. Believing not at all

in God or His Judgment, the foolish denizens of earth will arrive astonished before the throne of God on Judgment Day. When they hear the judgment of eternal damnation, they will something like, "How could this happen to me?" They should have learned long before that "It is appointed unto men once to die. but after this the judgment" (Heb. 9:27).

We can also observe that the Scripture states that the Day of Wrath is inevitable. It says, "For the great day of His wrath is come: and who shall be able to stand?" (Rev. 6:17). The great day of the wrath of God — what a statement! We know from the New Testament that man is treasuring up wrath against the Day of Wrath and revelation of the righteous Judgment of God, "Who will render to every man according to his deeds" (Rom. 2:6). For a long time now, the world has been amassing a treasure of divine wrath without ever considering the awful denouement of it all. Judgment Day is coming. Any person is a pitiful fool who does not make that consideration a first principle of life.

We have a final question, "Who shall be able to stand?" There is an answer to that question which we can announce with certainty and with joy. Who shall stand? Every person who has believed the Gospel of Jesus Christ and knows God's precious Son as personal Savior. Each one of these individuals will stand and will be unaffected by that final Judgment.

In fact, we will not stand as guilty before the King of the universe, but we will actually share His judgment throne. Yes, "the saints shall judge the world" (I Cor. 6:2). Having been delivered from all judgment by the death of Christ on Calvary's cross, we shall be a part of that judiciary which judges the world in that awful hour. Yes, we will be able to stand, undisturbed by the fires of divine retribution. The judgment which we deserve has already been poured out upon Christ at Calvary. We are, therefore, free from judgment, from condemnation. So it is that the Psalmist says, "The ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous" (Ps. 1:5).

We have a recommendation. then. As that awful hour of divine judgment draws near, each one of us must be sure that we know Jesus Christ as our Savior from sin's dreadful consequences. Let us also remind ourselves of the awful situation that is coming upon our world, which reminder should lead us to be overt, outstanding witnesses for Christ. Before the Judgment of God impacts this world with the velocity of an earthquake, we must snatch individuals like brands from the burning and bring them to the place of faith in Christ. Because of the shortening of time, no effort is more strategic than that of preaching the Gospel of the grace of God and offering to people the unsearchable riches of Christ. That is strategic activity indeed.



'Ere the sands of my time have their day?


How many moon-molten surfs will I see

Y OUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

Q. When is Christ coming again?

We are told in Scripture the fact of His coming, but we are not told the time of His coming. This because God wants us to live every day as believing that that day may be the time of the return of Christ. Nevertheless, we have the promise in Scripture: "He which testifies these things says, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord The grace of our Jesus. Lord Jesus Christ be with vou all. Amen" (Rev. 22:20-21).

Q. I am afraid to die. Is there any hope for me?

Fear of death is a troubling concern for many people. If you are a Christian, fear of death is easily countered by paying attention to the truth of Scripture. "Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, He also Himself likewise took part of the same; that through death He might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage" (Heb. 2:14). In Christ, we are absolved from the fear of death

Q. How does God speak to us today?

A. Scripture says, "God,

who at sundry times and in diverse manners spoke in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Has in these last days spoken to us by His son." (Heb. 1:1-2).

Q. I read much about success in life. Can I be a success?

The path to the **A.** beginning of success is plainly described Scripture, but it will not be followed by most people. The Scripture says, "For we can do nothing against the truth, but for the truth" (II Cor. 13:8). Millions of aspiring people are laboring in pitiful little pursuits which promise success but guarantee failure. The only activity that will produce a successful result is that activity which is "for the truth." Therefore the prelude to any real success is that we become masters of the truth, the truth of the Word of God. Without this, failure is assured.

Know the truth and then do it, this is the winning combination. Substitutes and chicanery accompany most people's efforts at "getting ahead." Truth is then ignored and the cause fails. Industrious labor on behalf of the truth is therefore the basic ingredient. Master this and you will be well on your way.

Q. If the Holy Spirit is

removed from the earth at the time of the Rapture, how will people be evangelized during the Tribulation?

A. To suppose that the Holy Spirit must stop operating in the world because Church, in which He dwelt, is no longer present, is erroneous. People were saved in the Old Testament economy, though the Holy Spirit did not indwell all believers in that age, as He does in this present Church Age. Nicodemus was reminded by Jesus, that the new birth by the Holy Spirit was necessary for salvation (John 3:3-5). That was prior to the coming of the Holy Spirit, also. Thus, in the Tribulation Age, the Holy Spirit will work just as He did when dealing with Israel before He indwelt the Church.

It should be recalled that the indwelling ministry of the Holy Spirit in the Church is as Comforter (John 16:7) and for power (Acts 1:8), both of which are apart from His work of regeneration. From this, it is evident that He will be able to regenerate even though not indwelling the believers during the Tribulation. As a member of the Godhead, He is not limited as to how He can perform His saving work, now or then, and remarkably, as the Millennium dawns, all flesh will experience His gracious and blessed ministry.

THINKING TOGETHER

BE STRONG

There is a simple admonition of Scripture which applies to every believer in Jesus Christ. If practiced, it would lead to remarkable Christian capability on the part of every child of God. It is contained in two simple words and constitutes a call for all who know Christ.

The two simple words are, "Be Strong." As we read the Bible, (which we should do every day), we find these words repeated. In fact, they are found so frequently in Scripture that one begins to suspect that God really means it when He tells us that we are to be strong. Let us, therefore, suggest just a few areas in which the Bible specifically tells us that we are to exercise strength, force, purpose, and determination.

First of all, we are to be strong for the Lord. We are never to be afraid of the opposition, but we are always to operate in the strength of the Lord. Whatever may be the form of opposition which we face, we are not to fear, but rather we are to be resolute Christians. Virtually every writer of the entire Bible brought up the subject of strength by which to operate for God. At the same time, virtually every writer confessed to his own human weakness, and therefore, the impossibility of accomplishing a great work by depending on his own strength and wisdom. Each one of these writers of the Word of God then reported that they were empowered with unusual strength because they had not depended upon themselves but upon the Lord. Therefore, the Scripture reports

that in their weakness, they were made strong. For instance, the Apostle Paul was able to write about how we can possess "the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power" (Eph. 1:19). When we are empowered by God, strengthened with His own courage, we find that the Lord is "able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us" (Eph. 3:20). There is no doubt that each one of us faces impossible problems, frightening difficulties, perplexity which is beyond our capability to solve. In the midst of all of this, however, if we determine to be strong in the Lord with His help, we will experience divine enablement far beyond our poor little powers. The Lord turns our weakness into strength! We know this because of hundreds of applicable promises in the Word of God.

Then we are admonished to be strong against the Devil. The Scripture tells us, "we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places" (Eph. 6:12). What then are we to do? "Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand" (Eph. 6:13).

The Devil is in serious confrontation before all of us. He wants to ruin your life, destroy the

work of God, and defeat the Church. So the Scripture seriously says, "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walks about, seeking whom he may devour: Whom resist steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world" (I Peter 5:8-9).

So, we as members of the army of the Lord, are in the "contingent of resistance" against His Infernal Majesty the Devil. The Devil should be seriously worried every day about the prospect of facing resolute Christians who are determined to be good soldiers for Christ.

The Scripture also indicates that there is coming a time when Satan will know his time is short and will go forth with great wrath (Rev. 12:12). We can, therefore, expect that pressure from the satanic side will increase. The battle, therefore, will grow stronger, the battle between Satan and the believers. This is not the time to run and hide. O indeed, it is the time to check our armor, strengthen our resolve, and be ready when the trumpet sounds.

We are also called upon to be strong in the Word. There are many Christians in today's world who do aspire to live a life of capability and consequence. They are seeking the strength by which they can be soldiers for Christ. Unfortunately, many are looking in the wrong direction. They are seekers of "the great experience,"
